Dear Student,

Effective January 1, 2017, California students may be eligible for tuition reimbursement if they were enrolled as of June 20, 2014 (or withdrew within 120 days of that date) at any Corinthian Colleges, Inc. campus (Heald, Everest or WyoTech) or in any online program of a Corinthian institution (including those located out-of-state).

The Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) reimburses eligible students' tuition and other specified educational costs following the closure of the college they attended. If you believe you are eligible for reimbursement, please complete the attached STRF application and submit it to the address listed on the application, including copies of the required corresponding documentation (e.g., enrollment agreement, receipts, etc.).

The Office of Student Assistance and Relief (OSAR) opened on July 1, 2017, and was created to advance and promote the rights of California students of private postsecondary educational institutions. This is why we are reaching out to you now - to inform you of your rights. We also are asking you to [complete a brief survey](#) so we can better-assist California students. Please complete the survey by **Friday, September 8, 2017**.
