Dear Student,

Effective January 1, 2017, California students may be eligible for tuition reimbursement if they were enrolled as of June 20, 2014 (or withdrew within 120 days of that date) at any Corinthian Colleges, Inc. campus (Heald, Everest or WyoTech) or in any online program of a Corinthian institution (including those located out-of-state).

The Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) reimburses eligible students' tuition and other specified educational costs following the closure of the college they attended. If you believe you are eligible for reimbursement, please complete the attached STRF application and submit it to the address listed on the application, including copies of the required corresponding documentation (e.g., enrollment agreement, receipts, etc.).

The OSAR staff is available Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to assist students with the completion of STRF applications, to answer questions about your eligibility for reimbursement, and to explain your rights among other services.

If you have previously received this message from our office and have already submitted a STRF application, there is no need to reapply.
